community statistics

- In Arizona, 918,9400 people (including 288,950 children) are struggling with hunger
- 1 in 8 people struggles with hunger
- 1 in 6 children struggles with hunger
- More than 72% of SNAP participants are in families with children
- People facing hunger in Arizona are estimated to report needing \$475,515,000 more per year to meet their food needs
- The average cost of a meal in Arizona is \$3.03

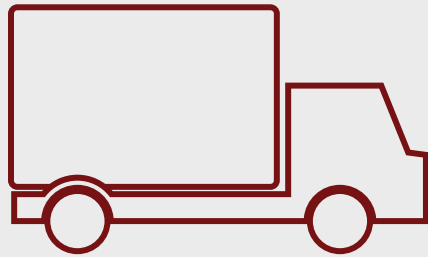

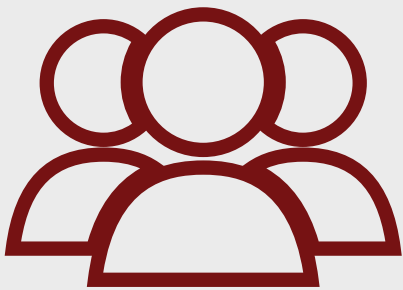
