community statistics

- People facing hunger in Arizona are estimated to report needing \$475,515,000 more per year to meet their food needs

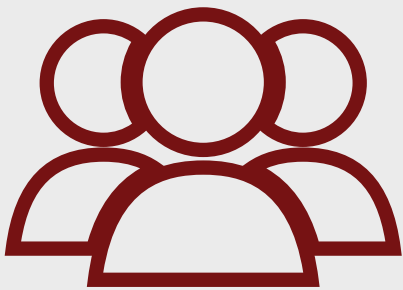
