

JLP's Ashley Bunch Awarded "40 under 40" at the 102nd AJLI Annual Conference

May 29, 2024 (Phoenix, AZ) – The Junior League of Phoenix is thrilled to announce Ashley Bunch, 2022-24 Executive Vice President, has been named to the Association of Junior Leagues International (AJLI) inaugural class of 40 Under 40. The award was formally given to Ashley on stage at the 102nd AJLI Annual Conference in New Orleans, LA on Wednesday, May 15.

The AJLI 40 Under 40 recognition aims to celebrate and honor outstanding Junior League Members who have demonstrated exceptional achievements in various fields and careers. To be eligible for consideration, nominees needed to demonstrate empowerment through her work and community involvement, leadership through her profession or area of service, and community impact in creating a positive impact on her community. AJLI, which comprises 298 Leagues, received dozens of nominations and a panel selected the top 40 from those nominations.



"When I think about a Junior League Member who has made an indelible impact on our League and community, it's Ashley Bunch," Kelly Kaysonepheth, 2022-24 President, said. "Ashley is a passionate and purpose-driven leader and the JLP is incredibly proud that the Association recognizes that too."
